Knowledge and Awareness

- Incorporate environmental and sustainability concerns into curriculums.
- Communicate ongoing environmental and sustainability research.

Resource Use and Emissions

- Minimise negative environmental impact, increase biodiversity on campus and reduce the use of natural resources.
- Take steps according to the Climate Roadmap to reduce the carbon footprint and achieve carbon neutrality by 2040.

Making Demands

- Promote environmental ambitions that surpass the University's mandatory commitments.
- Consider environmental and climate impact in decision-making.

Collaboration

- Engage with stakeholders to promote a sustainable environment, sustainable social development and climate transition.

Encourage

- Encourage and create conditions for employees and students to contribute to the work environment and sustainable development.

Evaluate

- Continuously evaluate and improve the University's environmental practices.
